The 3-point sleigh has two configurations, it is two points or three points. It refers to it being in a 1-point configuration when it is actually in the 3-point to the kick of the butt, one at the front of the rifle and the third is where the slip cycle is contacting the web part of the sled.....3 points. A slip point is that it is attached to one point of the firearm. When converting to the "test case" carry as it calls, metal crochet and double ring at the front must be configured as if in a 2-point configuration and safe. The same mode of transport is achieved by separating the two sections of the web. A web section is turned around the rifle as shown and reunited with each other to create a transport handle. Keeping the hook and double ring closed together there is no possibility of the metal loop sliding along the weblength not necessary to sleigh. 03-09-2017, 09:36 AM #5 The only other difference I can see between the sled originally imagined and the one in the video is that the sliding buckleOn the production harnesses has a larger gap where the snap hook passes. In the one shown it looks like you have to unhook the front and 3-point configuration while the production sling makes this transition without having to unhook. The slingshot you have can be an HK prototype, or possibly a third-party version avoiding copyright issues. I can't tell you which. This is all the information I have on this style slingshot. The picture in your quote shows the 3-point slingshot in a 2-point configuration, one attack point in the front and on the web part of the sling, it will be in a three-point configuration. An attack point in the front, one halfway on the web and one on the back on the head stock. That's all I have, I'm not sure when this style slingshot came out.
